## **Lafayette County Children's Services Fund Board Awards two Grants**

### **First, To a Coalition of Lafayette County Schools Brighter Futures Project**

Brighter Futures Project is for particular students enrolled in the six public school districts in the county between June 14, 2007 and June 13, 2008. Selected students will be referred to this project by their school district when psychological evaluation and/or counseling are needed beyond what the school district and family resources can provide. Services will be provided in the schools. Lexington R-V District will serve as the coordinator and fiscal agent for this \$260,000 grant.

### **Second, To Pathways Community Behavioral Healthcare, Inc.**

Pathways Community Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. received \$79,700 for services for uninsured youth and their families who are residents in Lafayette County. The range of services may be psychiatric evaluations and treatment; psychological evaluations; and individual, group and family counseling. The grant is from June 14, 2007 through June 13, 2008.
